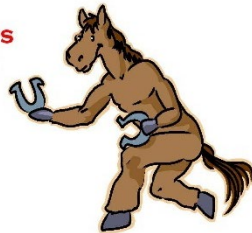
Upcoming event is August 17 being the J Hardwick horseshoe tournament-\$20 per team and you can pre-register at the bar.

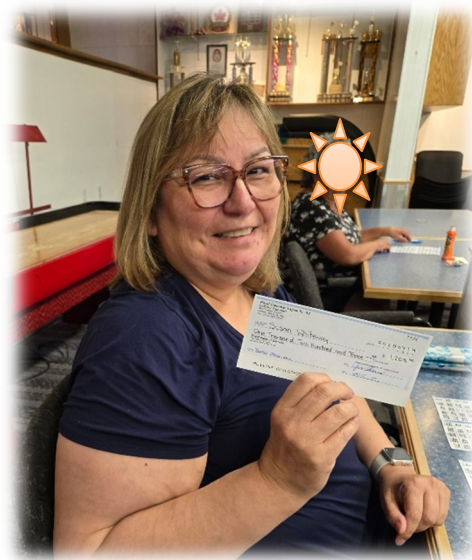

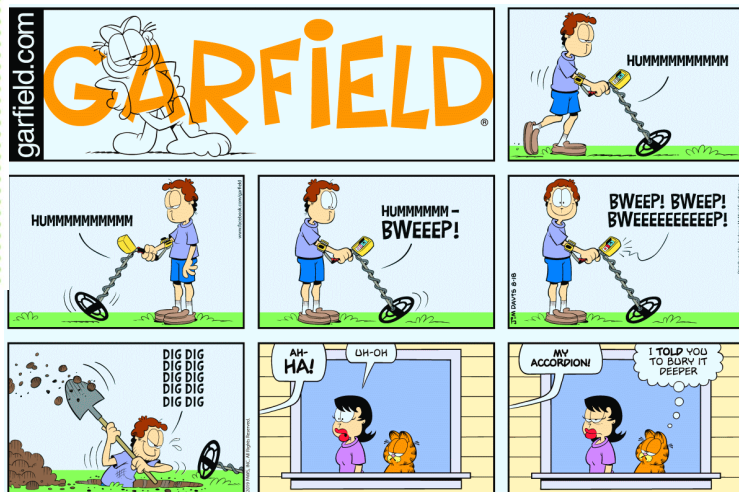
